

Sticky Church “Watch Your Mouth”

Matthew 5:33-37

What was the main point from the sermon?

2. Watching our mouths involve more than not saying four-letter words. Jesus commands that we watch our language. Read and study Matthew 12:36 and comment on the verse.

3. It is no unusual for Christian, even church leadership, to be unbiblical tied to Masonic Lodges or other ungodly organizations. However, it is even more common for Christians to make an unofficial oath to a pass time. What is taking your allegiance away from God? Will you resolve to abandon it?

4. Our family and the local church is what demands our allegiance by God. We show this allegiance with our attendance, prayers, and financial support. In which of these areas are you strong and in which are you weak? How can you improve?

5. We also make promises to God that we should not make. In the heat of the moment have you made a promise to God, and then failed to follow through? Detail it.

6. We must realize that when it comes to God, that we are in no position to bargain. Jesus forbids these types of promises. What have you tried to bargain with?

7. The church has never had as many biblical resources, yet it has never been as biblically illiterate as it is now. We foolishly believe and repeat lies about God which are unbiblical. Could you relate to any of the examples given in the sermon? Explain.

8. What are some more examples of unbiblical lies about God that churches repeat often?

9. The bottom line is that Christians are too ignorant of the Scriptures, and too many don't recognize anything unbiblical when they see it or hear it. What is the remedy for this?

10. Read and study James 3:1-18 and comment on it. How does this tie in to Jesus' words here.
